National workshop on LiFE, Lifestyle for Environment was held at Indira Paryavaran Bhawan, Ministry of Environment, Forest & climate Change, New Delhi on 30th of January 2023. The workshop saw participation of about 60 ‘Environmental Information, Awareness, Capacity Building and Livelihood Programme (EIACP) Centres across the nation.

Consumer Education and Research Centre (CERC) – EIACP PC RP works on the thematic mandate of “Environment literacy - Eco labelling and Eco-friendly Products”. For the past 20 years, CERC has been promoting sustainable production and consumption through its mandate by conducting various reach out programmes at schools, colleges and community level.

The theme of the stall was to promote sustainable lifestyle through green celebrations of the festivals and through sustainable routines. The exhibits included the following:
