DID YOU KNOW?

The Sundarbans, located in the south-west of Bangladesh between the river Baleswar in the East and the Harinbanga in the West adjoining to the Bay of Bengal, is the largest contiguous mangrove forest in the world. One mangrove tree removes 308kg (0.3 tonnes) of CO2 from the atmosphere over its growth life, which is 12.3kg per year.
