

Global greenhouse emissions is continuously increasing and Ecosystem lost has caused deprivation of carbon sinks such as forests, wetlands etc. The planet is in the verge of facing climate change repercussions. So this year's focus is on Ecosystem Restoration. And its theme is "Reimagine. Recreate. Restore". Ecosystem restoration means preventing, halting and reversing the damage – to go from exploiting nature to healing it. Pakistan as the host, on 5<sup>th</sup> June, 2021, World Environment Day kicked off UN decade on Ecosystem Restoration, a global mission to revive and rejuvenate the lost habitats and ecosystems of the world.
