 • Cooked Food/Leftovers • Eggshells
 • Chicken/Fish Bones • Rotten Fruits/
 Vegetables • Tissue Paper Soiled with food
 • Tea Bags/Coffee Grinds • Leaf Plates
- Garden Waste:** Fallen Leaves/Twigs
 • Puja Flowers/Garlands • Weeds



What Goes in the Blue Bin

- Plastic:** Plastic Covers/Bottles/Boxes/items
 • Chips/Toffee Wrappers • Plastic Cups
 • Milk/Curd Packets
- Paper:** Newspaper/Magazines • Stationery/
 Junk mail • Cardboard Cartons • Pizza Boxes
 • Tetrapacks • Paper Cups and Plates
- Metal:** Foil Containers • Metal Cans
- Other dry waste:** Rubber/Thermocol • Old mops/
 Dusters/Sponges • Cosmetics • Ceramics, Wooden
 Chips • Hair • Coconut Shells
