

REPORT ON VAN MAHOTSAV : 2020

Van Mahotsava is an annual tree planting festival celebrated in the first week of July. During this festival thousands of trees are planted all over India. CERC-ENVIS RP also hosted this programme in CERC campus and celebrated along with the entire CERC staff. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, plantation could not be done in large scale. This year, CERC-ENVIS team planted veggies in the CERC campus on 3rd July 2020. Vegetable/Fruits seeds such as Cherry, Eggplant, Green Chili, Tomato, Beetroot, Onion, Bitter Guard, Ladies finger, Coriander, Fenugreek etc were planted.
